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LESSON SUMMARY: REAL RELATIONSHIPS.

Who we are in relationship with is crucial to who we are. We often act like who we are with. Paul's metaphor of the yoke being equal in our relationships is a very important aspect in our walk. Those that we confide in, that we open up to, are they people that we can trust and make us grow?

In Acts, the people were with those that were at the same place as them in their walk. They challenged each other. Seeking God together, constantly serving and connecting with each other with God at the center. Remember this is the lens with which we are to see life.
